Tryout week attendance is **required** for all candidates. If a candidate must miss any portion of a practice, a signed note from the **teacher/coach** explaining the absence must be brought to the high school sponsors **prior** to the absence for it to be considered excused.

Tryout Eligibility Criteria

Students must meet the following criteria to be considered in the selection process for both cheerleader and mascot:

1. Students may have no more than one nine-week grade below 70 during the current school year. Any exceptions pertain to advanced (PAP/AP) classes and must follow district policies and UIL guidelines. Students must also have an overall average of 75 from the semester grades during the Fall 2023 semester.
2. No DAEP assignments during the school year.
3. No more than 3 days of ISS during the school year.
4. Students must be enrolled in a Deer Park ISD school at least six weeks prior to the final day of squad selection.
5. Students must be in good standing with any other DPISD school organization/program.

-Clinics and tryouts are closed. Only tryout candidates, coaches, and other personnel required for the clinic/tryouts will be allowed. No parents will be allowed.

Tryout Material

The tryout material will be posted in Canvas on Saturday, March 2nd. It is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED that the candidates watch those videos and learn the material prior to the clinic.

Candidates will be added to the Canvas course once their paperwork is received.

Tryout Attire

Females:

- Black sleeveless top
 - Black spandex shorts
 - White cheer/athletic shoes
 - White socks
 - Hair: Slicked low ponytail with a white bow (no wispies or pieces of hair down around face)
 - No jewelry of any kind
 - Tattoos must be covered
 - No colored nail polish (white & nude are the only colors allowed. Nails must also not be of excessive length).
 - No bra straps showing (with the exception of sports bras)
 - **Make-Up:**
 - Mascara or Lashes
 - Blush/Highlighter
 - Red Lipstick
- *Candidates may wear more than what is required**

Males:

- Black t-shirt
- Black athletic shorts
- Athletic shoes
- No jewelry of any kind
- Tattoos must be covered

Teams

The number of athletes on each team varies from year to year. Cut off for teams will occur at the natural break in scores.

Varsity – the most accomplished 9th, 10th, and 11th grade candidates (optional placement of current freshman – must be in top scores).

Junior Varsity – the most accomplished students from the remaining 9th and 10th grade candidates.

Freshman – the most accomplished students from the 8th grade candidates.

Mascot – the most accomplished student from the 9th, 10th, and 11th grade candidates.

Competition Teams

The competition teams are inner-program teams that are comprised of Freshman, JV, and Varsity members. Not every athlete will make a competition team, but all athletes will be required to try out for placement on a team. Coaches will place athletes on team(s) that best fits the athlete's skill level. If an athlete earns a spot on a competition team(s), their spot does not remain guaranteed. Athletes can be removed or replaced for various reasons, discipline, grades, attitude, skills, etc.

NCA (Performance) Team

March 25 – May 15: Wednesday practices will focus on competition skills. Teams will be finalized in August.

Summer Practices: There will be 1-2 practices scheduled each week for the performance team throughout the summer at All-Star Revolution. These practices are typically from 10am-noon on Tuesdays & Thursdays.

Mandatory Choreography Camp: Typically scheduled for August/September. Dates will be given as soon as they are scheduled with ASR.

Weekly Practices August-February: The NCA team will train off campus at All-Star Revolution on Wednesdays during 7th period. UIL team will practice on Tuesdays on campus.

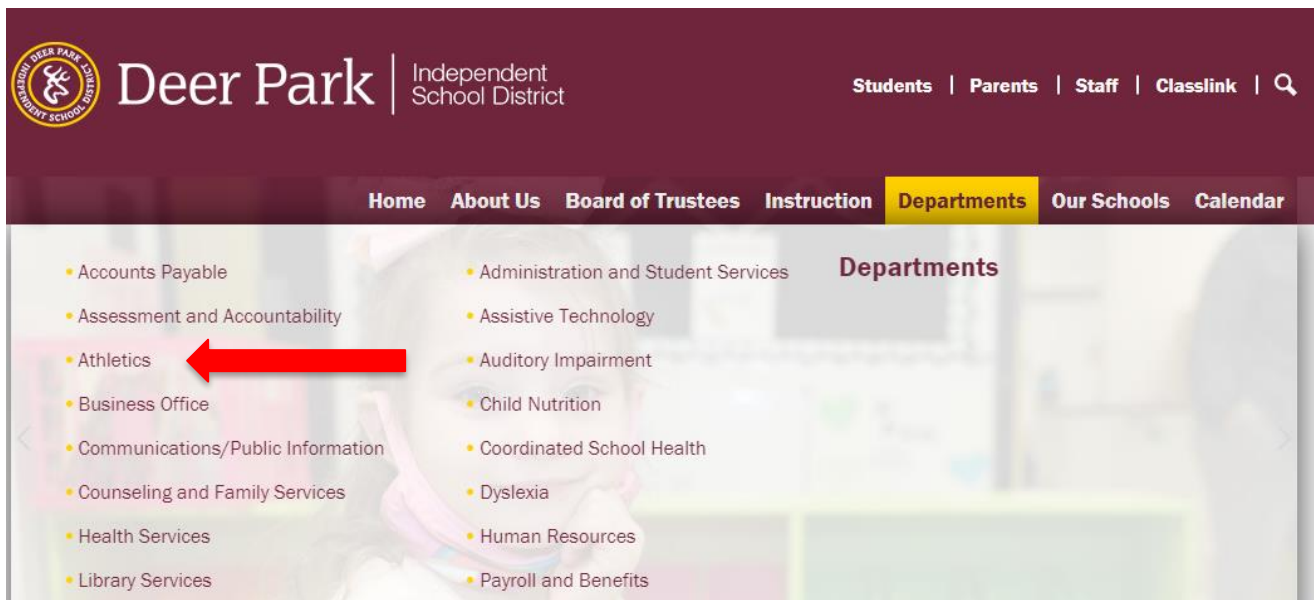

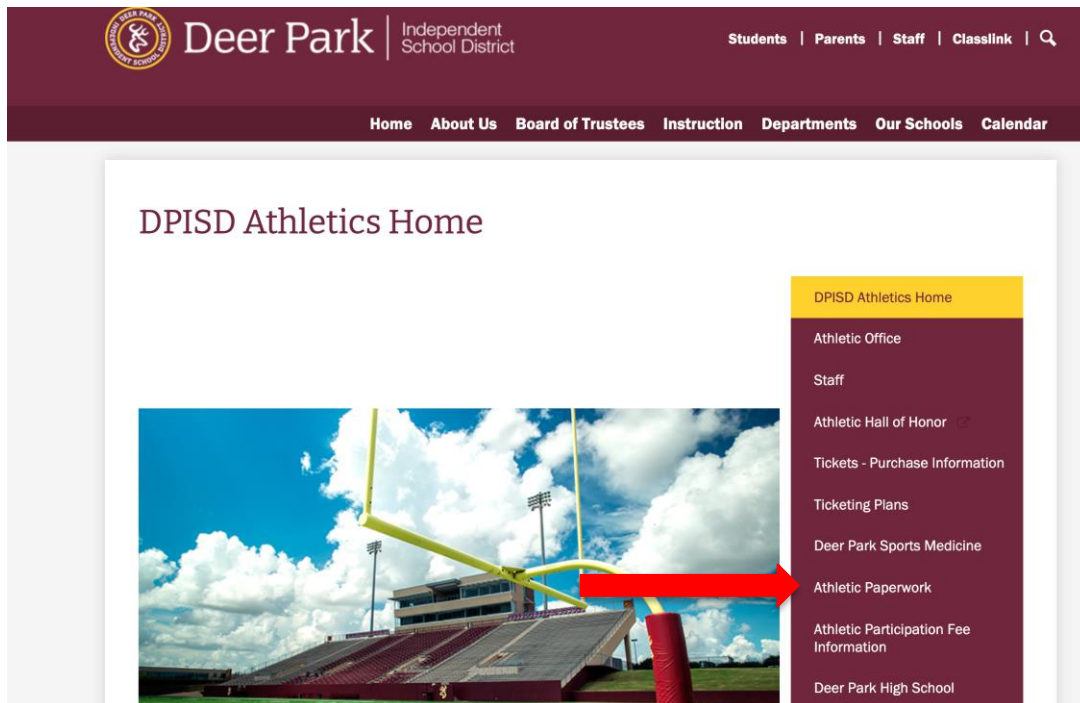

Physicals and Medical History forms:
Due to the covid-19 virus, the UIL changed the pre-participation physical exam requirement for athletes and marching band members.

Summarily:

1. All athletes and marching band members will have to complete the medical history form, which is now offered as an electronic form.
2. Only athletes and marching band members who do not have a current physical on file or who answer yes to questions 1-6 on the medical history form will have to obtain a physical exam.
 - a. All incoming 7th graders will have to obtain a physical exam.
 - b. Most 8th - 12th grade students will not have to obtain a new physical exam.
 - c. For those who need it, the physical form is found under the download and print tab. Physicals must be completed online and returned to the athletic trainers or Junior High head coaches.
3. This change only affects the physical exam and medical history. All other online forms will continue to be required as usual.
4. These changes are only in effect for the 2020/2021 school year.

Please complete the form and return with your payment to the athletic trainers or the campus bookkeepers. You may also return your form during early registration. See the form for more information.

- 1) Please make sure all information is accurate, as this will be used in case of emergency.
- 2) Parent/Guardian AND Student signatures are required in order for forms to be accepted electronically.
- 3) To access the required athletic participation forms, place your cursor over the "Electronic Participation Forms" tab and click on the drop down menu.
- 4) Click on the form name and fill out the information requested. If you are unsure about the answer to a question, click on the "Not Applicable or Unknown" button.
- 5) To sign the document click inside the signature box and hold your mouse down, this will allow you to create an electronic signature. If you make a mistake and need to start over, click on the refresh icon next to the signature box.
- 6) Once you have completed each form, you will have the opportunity to print the document. Athletic Questionnaire forms are 9 – 12 pages long.
- 7) You will receive a confirmation email once the documents have been reviewed by the DPISD Athletic Trainers.
- 8) Write N/A in any required fields that do not apply to you. All required fields must have something in the box.

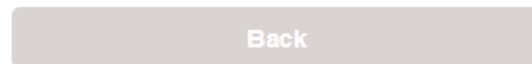
